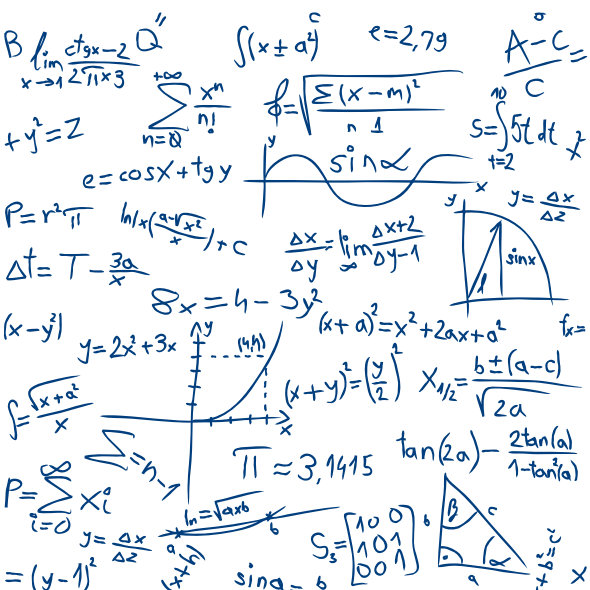
THE LANGUAGE OF MATHS
